(a) & (b): Major centrally sponsored schemes that are being implemented by the Union Government for the purpose of eradicating poverty and hunger in the country include National Food Security Mission (NFSM), Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana (SJSRY), National Programme Nutritional Support to Primary Education (MDM), Rashtriya Swasthya Bima Yojana (RSBY), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme, Indira Awas Yojana, Swaranjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY) and Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Scheme. The detailed Ministry wise/scheme wise and year wise allocation for these schemes are annexed.
