(a) The Government of India is implementing the following schemes for dairy development in the country including Karnataka:

1. Intensive Dairy Development Programme (IDDP)
2. Assistance to Cooperatives (A to C)
3. Strengthening Infrastructure for Quality and Clean Milk Production (SIQ&CMP)
4. Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme (DEDS)

The details of the schemes implemented by Government of India for dairy development in the country including Karnataka is at Annexure-I

(b) The statement indicating the funds allocated for dairy development under National Agricultural Development Programme (Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY)) during last three years is at Annexure-II.
