DEVELOPMENT OF ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

**Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of the proposals received from various State Governments including Uttar Pradesh, so far regarding development of animal husbandry and dairying under the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY);
- (b) the action taken by the Government thereon; and
- (c) the time by which the proposals are likely to be cleared?

**Answer**

(a) to (c) Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) is a State Plan Scheme, which was launched in August 2007 with an envisaged outlay of Rs. 25,000 crore for the 11th Plan Period. The funds are released to State Governments on the basis of projects approved in the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting headed by the Chief Secretary and are implemented by the concerned States.

From the year 2007-08 to 2011-12, 814 proposals of Animal Husbandry and 185 proposals of Dairy Development from various States/UTs including Uttar Pradesh under RKVY have been approved. The State-wise and year-wise details of projects are Annexed.
