- (a) & (b) No, Madam. The draft policy proposals are still under inter-ministerial discussion.
- (c) & (d) The draft proposes the creation of National Investment and Manufacturing Zones(NIMZs) as integrated industrial townships with state-of-the-art infrastructure. These are envisaged to be different from Special Economic Zones in terms of size, level of infrastructure planning and governance structures related to regulatory procedures.
