- (d) whether any financial assistance is being provided to the States for the said purpose; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a): Yes, Madam.
- (b) & (c): Soil testing is a continuous process for recommendation of fertilizers and monitoring of soil fertility based on type of soils, crops grown and nutrient status of soil.
- (d) & (e): Under National Project on Management of Soil Health & Fertility (NPMSH&F), financial assistance is provided to the States for setting up/ strengthening of soil testing laboratories, trainings and demonstrations on balanced use of fertilizers and promoting use of organic manure, soil amendments and micronutrients.

Financial assistance is also provided for this purpose under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojna (RKVY) and Macro Management of Agriculture (MMA) Scheme.
