## Answer

However, Government of India, Ministry of Water Resources has released an amount of Rs. 1123.582 crore under Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP) for development of major/medium irrigation projects benefitting drought prone area in Bundelkhand and Vindhyachal region of Uttar Pradesh.
