- (a) & (b) The Government of Maharashtra submitted proposals for three districts, viz., Beed Nanded and Yavatmal during Xth Plan under the Pilot Scheme `National Project for Repair, Renovation and Restoration of water bodies directly linked to Agriculture`.
- (c) The Government of India sanctioned project for restoration of 32 water bodies in Beed district of Maharashtra at the estimated cost of Rs.36.88 crore.
