- (b): NFL has taken up capacity augmentation of Ammonia and Urea plants at its Vijaipur I & II units at an investment of Rs. 650 crores. The projects were taken up for execution in year 2010-2011. The details of the projects are as under:

Urea capacity after augmentation 3030 MTPD 3231 MTPD
% augmentation in urea capacity 16% 23%

The Government has also approved for revival of Fertilizers Corporation of India-Sindri and Ramagundam plants through a consortium of National Fertilizers Limited (NFL) & Steel Authority of India (SAIL) and NFL & Engineers India Limited (EIL) respectively. The preliminary activities for both these projects have been initiated.
