(a) to (e): No, Sir. All schemes of the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports and those of the Sports Authority of India (SAI) relating to sports infrastructure, training, participation in competitions, cash incentives, awards and welfare are open for both sportsmen and sportswomen. Similarly even assistance provided to national sports federations caters to both men and women sportspersons.

There is no separate earmarking of funds for women sportspersons except in case of the Scheme of National Championship for Women, for which the funds allocation during last three years has been as follows:
