THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI NAMO NARAIN MEENA)

NCDC has sanctioned and released Rs.5 crore and Rs.100 crore to Firozabad District Cooperative Bank and Lakhimpuri District Cooperative Bank respectively. NCDC has reported that District Cooperative Bank in Lucknow has not approached NCDC for assistance.
