- (a) whether the Government proposes to include sports in school curriculum to nurture talents in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the number of physical education teachers available for this purpose;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to issue guidelines to the State Governments for including sports in school curriculum and appointment of physical education teachers;
- (d) if so, the details thereof alongwith the time frame fixed for the purpose; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government for its speedy implementation?

(a) to (e) Both New Education Policy 1986 and National Curriculum framework 2005 provide that sports and physical education are an integral part of the learning process, and are necessary for overall development of learners.
