(a) & (b): The estimated loss is a function of a number of variables such as, international price, exchange rate, quantum of imports and domestic consumption. The estimated revenue loss for reduction in basic customs duty on petroleum crude, petrol, diesel and other refined products and in basic excise duty on diesel is likely to be Rs.49,000 crore for the full financial year. The details are placed as Annexure-I.

(c) & (d): Instructions have been issued to strengthen the tax administration by certain measures such as, identification of stop filers, conducting special audit, liquidation of arrears.
