Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has received any proposal from the State Government of Maharashtra under the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM);
- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof, as on date; and
- (c) the time by which the proposal is likely to be finalised alongwith the reasons for delay therein?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (KUMARI SELJA)

(a) to (c): Total 55 projects under the Sub-Mission Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) and 107 projects under the Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP)- components of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) coordinated by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation have been sanctioned for construction of 1,54,750 and 99,224 dwelling units respectively. 6 projects under BSUP and 8 projects under IHSDP were returned to the State Government for modification. No project under BSUP and IHSDP is pending with the Government.

The Government of Maharashtra has requested for replacement of non- starter projects by new ones and the same has been agreed to. Proposals received from the State Governments are processed and considered by the Sanctioning Committee at the Central level as received from time to time.
