(a) & (b): No, Madam. However, NCR Planning Board conducted a Study on `Integrated Transportation Plan for NCR`. The study identified the need for Eight intercity rail corridors in NCR to facilitate commuters. The tentative length and cost details of the corridors as per that study are given below:-
