- (a) Conservation work of the monuments is a continuous process. Every year & special repair work is taken up at the selected monuments depending upon
- (b) the need of the repairs and availability of resources. However annual repairs work of routine maintenance is attended to, at all the protected monuments. The details of the monuments in Karnataka, taken up for special repairs work in the current financial year, are at annexure. The details of amount spent for conservation work, during the last three years, for protected monuments in the State are as under:
