(a) to (e):- A proposal to allow Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) by foreign airlines in Domestic Airlines is under examination of Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP).

Foreign Ownership limits for investment in airlines in other developed countries are as under:

USA 25% of voting stock

Japan 33%

Australia & NZ 49% for international carriers/ a single foreign airlines upto 25%

Australia 100% (in domestic airlines)

China 35%

Brazil 20%

Singapore 100%

UAE 49%

South Korea 50%
