**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of the cost of rail components of Mumbai Urban Transport Project (MUTP) and the Central and State cost sharing pattern of the project;
- (b) the total cost of rail components of (BUTP-II) project;
- (c) the progress made so far in this regard; and
- (d) the time by which the said project is likely to be completed?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS(SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c) Total cost of the Rail components of MUTP Phase I and Phase II are Rs. 4175 crore and Rs. 5300 crore respectively to be shared equally by Ministry of Railways and Government of Maharashtra.

The Bombay Urban Transport Project-II (BUTP-II) was renamed as Mumbai Urban Transport Project (MUTP) after re-christening of Bombay as Mumbai.

MUTP –II has been sanctioned in the Railway Budget 2008-09. The project has been planned for implementation in two parts. The 1st part, MUTP-2A includes, Procurement of new EMUs rakes, DC to AC conversion, Maintenance facilities for EMUs & Stabling lines for EMUs.

The executing agencies viz. Central Railway, Western Railway and Mumbai Rail Vikas Corporation (MRVC) have been assigned the sub-projects and work has commenced.

(d) The MUTP-II project is targeted to be completed by 2013-14.
