(a) to (c): Nangaldam-Talwara new line is a 83.74 km long project out of which 44 km long Nangaldam-Amb Andaura section has been completed and commissioned. Funds have been made available for the project as per the requirement for the year 2011-12.

(d): The target date of completion for the balance portion of the work has not yet been fixed.
