STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 22 FOR ANSWER ON 23.11.2011 REGARDING "MODEL SCHOOLS" ASKED BY SHRI DHARMENDRA YADAV AND SHRI ADHALRAO PATIL SHIVAJI, HON'BLE MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT

(a) to (e): The centrally sponsored scheme to set up 6,000 model schools at block level was launched in November, 2008. Out of these, 3,500 schools are to be set up in educationally backward blocks (EBBs) through State/UT Governments, and the remaining 2,500 schools are proposed to be set up under Public - Private Partnership (PPP) mode in blocks which are not educationally backward. State-wise number of blocks and EBBs is at Annexure.

Modalities for setting up such model schools under PPP mode are in the process of approval. The scheme is proposed to be launched in the 12th Five Year Plan.
