- (a): No, Madam.An updating survey for doubling of Meerut-Saharanpur was completed in 2005-06. As per the said survey, the cost of doubling of this 114 km long section was assessed as Rs. 238 crore with a Rate of Return (ROR) of minus 7.83%. The proposal was not considered viable.
