Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Delhi-Baghat-Shamli-Saharanpur highway is in an extremely dilapidated condition;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps for repairing and two-laning of said NH; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof alongwith the time by which the said works are likely to be completed?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) to (d): This Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways in the Country. The road in question i.e. Delhi-Baghat-Shamli-Saharanpur Highway is not a part of National Highway System. This Highway is under the control of Government of Uttar Pradesh. The responsibility for the maintenance, development of the said Highway does not fall under the purview of this Ministry.
