- (a) & (b): A complaint regarding irregularity in sale of land of Finlay Mills in Western Region of National Textiles Corporation Limited had been received by the government.
- (c) & (d): The case has been referred to the Central Vigilance Commission. To ensure transparency in Sale of land, sales are done through an open tender with the approval of an Assets Sale Committee in accordance with the guidelines of the Board for Industrial & Financial Reconstruction. Recently, NTC has also introduced a system of e-auction for sale of land.
