- (a) whether the Railways have received proposals from various States, especially from Rajasthan for construction of overbridges at level crossings;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the action taken by the Railways on the said proposals;
- (d) the locations where overbridges are to be constructed at railway level crossings, State-wise; and
- (e) the time by which the said work is likely to be completed?

- (a): Yes, Madam.
- (b): During 2009-10 Works Programme, in all 102 firm proposals were received from State Govt. out of which only one proposal was from Rajasthan for sanction on cost sharing basis during 2009-10 Works Programme. The detail is as under:
