ATOMIC POWER PLANTS BY NTPC

**Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:**

- (a) the present status of atomic power plants being developed by the National Thermal Power Corporation Limited (NTPC) in the country, plant-wise, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the total power generated capacity of these plants to be established;
- (c) whether the NTPC proposes to establish any such plant in Uttarakhand; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI K.C. VENUGOPAL)

(a) & (b): NTPC has formed a Joint Venture Company with Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL). NPCIL is holding majority share of 51% and NTPC 49%, to develop a nuclear power plant based on indigenous/imported technology at one of the sites to be selected by NPCIL.

(c) & (d): NTPC has not planned to set up Atomic Power Plant in Uttarakhand.
