(a) Under National Rural Health Mission, funding to the field level NGOs has been decentralized. State Governments are provided funds based on the requirements projected in their Annual Programme Implementation Plan. Details of funds approved under NRHM for the States/UTs during the last three years are at Annexure- I. Government of India releases funds directly to the 10 functional Regional Resource Centers, the details on which are at Annexure –II. Details of funds released to NGOs for undertaking activities related to Pre-Conception and pre-Natal Diagnostics Techniques(PC-PNDT) prevention activities by the Government of India are at Annexure-III

(b) & (c) Regarding PNDT activities, an adverse track verification Record has been received from District Magistrate, Fatehpur District, (UP) against Manav Kalyan Pratishthan, Fatehpur, Uttar Pradesh. A Showcause notice has been issued to the NGO.
