**Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:**

- (a) Whether the employees of Coal India Limited (CIL) were on strike for one day for their demands in the month of October;
- (b) If so, the details of their demands and the details of the amount of loss suffered by the CIL as a result thereof; and
- (c) The details of the steps taken by the Government to prevent such incidents in future and to meet the demands of the employees?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COAL(SHRI PRATIK PRAKASHBAPU PATIL)

(a) Yes, Sir. All Central Trade Unions (CTUs) went on one day token strike on 10th October, 2011.

(b)& (c) : The demands of the Trade Unions are to pay Rs.25,000/- as Performance Linked Reward/Bonus and Rs.1,000/- as ex-gratia for the year 2009-10. Coal India Limited has reported 70.87% of loss in production of Coal during the strike. The demands of CTUs have been amicably resolved in a meeting held on 17th October, 2011.
