(a) to (d): The National Development Council (NDC) had approved an outlay of Rs.84943 crore for the Department of Higher Education during the Eleventh Five Year Plan (2007- 12). Against the budgeted Plan Allocation of Rs.34683 crore during the first 4 years of the Eleventh Five Year Plan, the actual expenditure was Rs.27004.84 crore which is about 78%. The plan allocation for the year 2011-12 is Rs.13103 crore.
