- (b) whether these employees are not being paid suitably as per their duty hours; and
- (c) if so, the manner in which the Government proposes to increase their salaries and regularize their jobs?

(a) to (c): Under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) programme, 6% of the total outlay of every State/UT is allowed towards Management Cost, from which the salary of staff deputed to or engaged under SSA programme is met by States/UTs. The staff under SSA programme are paid remuneration by the respective States/UTs as per their Service Rules/Contract of engagement.
