(a): The Mahatma Gandhi Antarrashtriya Hindi Vishwavidyalaya, (MGAHV), Wardha, is a Central University established under the Mahatma Gandhi Antarrashtriya Hindi Vishwavidyalaya Act, 1996. The University is governed by the said Act and the Statutes and Ordinances made thereunder.

(b) & (c): As per the information received from MGAHV, Wardha, the University endeavours to fulfil its objectives through various teaching and research programmes as well as activities like publications, creation of audio-visual aids, national and international seminars and assisting teachers of foreign universities in developing curriculum, course material and tools necessary for teaching Hindi as a foreign language. Pursuance of the objectives of the University under the control, supervision and guidelines of the Statutory bodies is an ongoing process.
