(a) Yes, Madam.

(b) The Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) launched a new scheme National Initiative on Climate Resilient Agriculture (NICRA) in January, 2011 with an outlay of Rs.350 crores for the period 2010-12. The scheme aims to assess the impact of climate change on agriculture and allied sectors in the country and evolve cost effective adaptation and mitigation strategies.

(c) The demonstration of climate resilient technologies to cope with drought, floods, heat at farmers' filed in 100 vulnerable districts of 27 States and one Union Territory has been planned from 2011-12 onwards. The details are at (Annexure).
