Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Health Department of Andaman & Nicobar (A&N) Administration had sent samples of medicines for laboratory test to Central Drugs laboratory, Kolkata in August 2010 out of which six samples were found substandard;
- (b) if so, the name of such suppliers and the details of action taken against the suppliers for supplying substandard medicines;
- (c) the total quantity of such substandard medicines purchased with cost during the last five years;
- (d) whether any further test of medicines procured by the Health Department has been got done through the Drugs Laboratory Kolkata; and
- (e) if so, the details alongwith the results thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD)

- (a) The Health Department of Andaman & Nicobar (A&N) Administration had sent eleven samples of medicines for laboratory test to Central Drugs laboratory, Kolkata in May, 2010 out of which five samples were found 'not of standard quality'.
- (b) The names of the concerned suppliers are:
- (i) M/s B.R. Marketing, Port Blair
- (ii) M/s C.S.B. Agencies, Port Blair
- (iii) M/s Medi Rasayan, Chennai
- (iv) M/s Medicos India, Chennai

Andaman & Nicobar (A&N) Administration has informed that action has been initiated against these suppliers for supplying substandard medicines.
