Request regarding introduction of a train between Saharanpur and Ambala has been examined but not found feasible for implementation at present. Regarding late reaching of train No. 14681 from New Delhi to Jalandhar Intercity Express at Saharanpur, the zonal railway has been asked to make all efforts including launching of punctuality drive to improve its punctual arrival at Saharanpur.
