(a)&(b): Yes Sir. The 3rd meeting of the Council of National Institutes of Technology (NITs) held on 18.11.2011 considered the proposal formulated by Dr. T. Ramasami Committee on Alternate System for admission to undergraduate programmes in Science and Engineering in the country as presented before the IIT Council. It endorsed the adoption of the same which envisage a single national examination for admission to under graduate programmes in Science and Engineering with weightage given to the marks obtained by the students in class 12th board examination after statistical normalization of performance vis-Ã -vis the average performance of other students appearing in the respective board examinations.

(c) & (d): The report of the Dr. T. Ramasami has since been received and the same is under examination in the Ministry.
