- (c) the funds allocated and released for National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) and Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Yojana (PMSY) separately during the last three years and the current year, year-wise;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to increase the allocation under these heads;and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) No Madam.For the Annual Plan 2009-10 BE for the Department of Health Family Welfare including AIDS control stands at Rs. 18,380 crores as against a budget outlay of Rs. 15,580 crores in 2008-09.

(c) Details of funds allocated and released for National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) and Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Surakasha Yojana (PMSSY) for the last three years and the current year's outlay for these 2 programmes is given below:
