2. Rs.1,800/- Rs. 1,900/-, Rs.2,000/-, 15,000/-
Rs. 2,400/-, and Rs. 2,800/- per month
3. Rs.4,200/- per month 27,000/-
4. Rs.4,600/-, Rs.4,800/-, Rs.5,400/- 39,000/-
and Rs.6,600/- per month

5. Rs.7,600/- and above per month 60,000/-
