(a)to(c): National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has reported that drinking water projects are one of the eligible activities financed under the Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) by NABARD. The State-wise details of disbursement made by NABARD under RIDF for Rural Drinking Water during the last three years and the current year are given in the Annex.
