Will the Minister of PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether handicapped persons are provided reservation in civil services exams;
- (b) if so, the exam-wise percentage of reservation;
- (c) the number of handicapped persons not selected by the UPSC after passing the IAS exam; and
- (d) the reaction of the Government thereto?

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. 3% of vacancies are reserved for candidates appearing in the Civil Services Examination (CSE) with disability of which 1% each reserved for persons suffering from (i) blindness or low vision; (ii) hearing impairment; (iii) locomotor disability or cerebral palsy, in the posts/services identified by the various Cadre Controlling Authorities of the services participating in the CSE.

(c) & (d) : All PH candidates who have qualified the Civil Services Examination have been recommended by Union Public Service Commission (UPSC).
