- (a) whether there has been delay in supplying water from the Upper Ganga Lead to Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the steps taken by the Union Government to expedite the process;
- (d) whether any Memorandum has been signed between the State Governments of Haryana and Rajasthan regarding the same; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) No Madam, There is no such proposal. However, the National Water Development Agency (NWDA) is studying the Feasibility of Sardar-Yamuna & Yamuna-Rajasthan Link under National Perspective Plan (NPP). The link will divert the surplus water of Sardar river which is a tributary of Ganga to provide water for drinking & Irrigation purpose in Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Haryana & Rajasthan.
