(a) whether the Government proposes to give a bigger push to its eight flagship schemes;

(b) if so, whether the Government has increased its Budgetary Support (GBS) by a mammoth 43% in allocation of flagship programme;

(c) if so, the extent to which these allocations are expected to implement these schemes in a bigger way; and

(d) the details of schemes where additional resources are proposed to be allocated?

(a) and (b): Yes Madam. As against the Budgetary Allocation of Rs. 70,840 crore in 2008-09, Rs. 1,03,119 crore has been provided for flagship schemes in 2009-10 (July, 2009 – Union Budget), which amounts to an increase of about 45% over 2008-09 BE.
