Under the scheme total 69,803 women Self- Help Groups (SHGs) were formed covering 10,02,279 beneficiaries in the country till its end. State /UT-wise list including Chhatishgarh and Odisha alongwith physical achievement under the scheme is at Annex.

(f) & (g): At present, there is no proposal to launch new scheme to promote Self-Help Groups for women.
