(a) & (b). Based on the request of Central Mine Planning and Design Institute Limited/Coal India Limited, Ministry of Coal has approached Ministry of Environment and Forests for relaxing the guidelines of Ministry of Environment and Forests under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for drilling upto 15-20 boreholes per Sq. Km. from present level of 15-20 boreholes per 10 Sq. Km. for both opencast (OC) and underground (UG) coal mining projects without the need for obtaining forest clearance.
