- (a) whether the Government has conducted any survey to collect information regarding socio-economic conditions of the Scheduled Tribes in the country;
- (b) if so, the details and the outcome thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any survey on declining of population of various tribes during the past few years;
- (d) if so, the details and the outcome thereof, State-wise, tribes-wise and year-wise; and
- (e) the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

- (a) & (b): In so far as Ministry of Tribal Affairs is concerned, no specific survey has been conducted regarding socio-economic conditions of the Scheduled Tribes in the country. However, National Sample Survey Organization (NSSO) of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation conducts multi-subject integrated sample surveys in the form of successive rounds on country-wide basis relating to social, economic, demographic, industrial and agricultural statistics in respect of all social groups, including Scheduled Tribes (STs).
- (c), (d) & (e): No, Madam. No report has been received from any State Government so far regarding declining population of various tribes in the country.
