(a) to (d): "Education" is in the Concurrent List of the Constitution. Parliament as well State Legislatures are empowered to incorporate Universities. Central Government is fully committed to ensuring autonomy of Universities established by central legislations. All Central Universities in the country enjoy full academic and administrative autonomy. Central Government does not interfere in any of the powers and functions of central Universities. Universities set up by State Legislatures are governed by their respective Acts.
