MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. D. PURANDESWARI)

(a) to (c) : No, Sir. There is no proposal with the Government to set up Centres of Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) in each State. AMU is an autonomous organization established under Aligarh Muslim University Act 1920 and is governed by its Act, Statutes and Ordinances made there under. AMU has established Centres at Murshidabad (West Bengal) and Malappuram (Kerala).
