IMPROVEMENT IN IIMS EDUCATION

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether in view of changing scenario, the Government proposes to bring changes in the standard of education at Indian Institute of Management (IIMs) and introduce new courses for other sectors;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to provide funds for buildings, hostels, research and educational works in the IIMs; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the time by which funds are likely to be provided?

Answer

- (a) & (b): No Sir. As the Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) are autonomous bodies, Government does not propose to bring changes in the standard of education or to introduce new courses in the IIMs.
- (c) & (d): Government proposes to continue providing grants-in-aid to the new IIMs for construction of permanent campuses and for infrastructural development under OSC to the older IIMs.
