- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the work of doubling on this line is likely to be started/completed?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) & (b): Survey for doubling of Delhi-Shahdara-Shamli single line section has been taken up. Further decision on the project will be taken after the survey is completed and survey report examined in the Ministry. Shamli is further connected to Saharanpur via Tapri on which Tapri-Saharanpur section is a double line section. Doubling of the intervening Shamli-Tapri single line section is presently not under consideration.
- (c): Does not arise as the project has not yet been sanctioned.
