STOPPAGE OF TRAINS AT ALIGARH STATION

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of the request made for stoppage of train nos. 12303, 12033, 12034, 14006 and 12306 at Aligarh station;
- (b) whether these trains are proposed to be provided a stoppage at Aligarh station and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether funds have been released for the construction of overbridge near rail crossing in Aligarh;
- (e) if so, the time by which the construction of the said overbridge is likely to be started; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c) The requests for stoppages of 14005/14006 Sitamarhi-Anand Vihar Lichchavi Express, 12033/12034 Kanpur-New Delhi Shatabdi Express and 12305/12306 Howrah-New Delhi Rajdhani Express at Aligarh station have been examined. Instructions for provision of stoppage of 14005/14006 Sitamarhi-Anand Vihar Lichchavi Express at Aligarh station have been issued. 12303/12304 Howrah-New Delhi Poorva Express is already stopping at Aligarh station. However, stoppages of other trains at Aligarh is not feasible at present.

(d) to (f) The work of Rail Overbridge (ROB) in lieu of level crossing no.111-A at Km 1327/33-35 has been sanctioned in the year 2010-11. However, ROB has not been found feasible due to location of Jail Boundary and university campus.
