- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the work on the said project is likely to be started/completed?

(a) to (c): An updating survey for Alwar-Bandikui doubling project (60.37 kms) has recently been completed and examination of the survey report has been taken up. As per the survey report, abstract cost of the project is Rs. 245.78 cr. The time of start/completion of the project cannot be decided as project is not yet sanctioned.
