- (a) As per the updated National Register of Large Dams prepared by Central Water Commission(CWC), the total number of completed large dams in India is 4728. No survey has been conducted by Government of India to ascertain the utilization level of these dams.
- (b) & (c) Irrigation being a State subject, the planning, execution, operation and maintenance of irrigation projects are carried out by State Governments from their own resources as per their own priorities.
