(a) whether a large number of violations of mines safety norms have been taking place in the mines across the country;

(b) if so, the number of notices/letters regarding violation of mines safety norms issued by the Directorate General of Mines Safety (DGMS) during the last two years, State-wise;

(c) whether certain reports about corrupt practices in issuing such notices/letters by DGMS office have come to the notice of the Government; and

(d) if so, the reaction of the Government in this regard?
